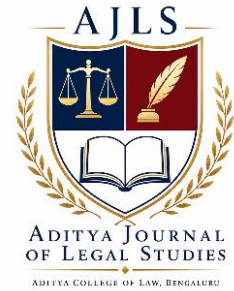

Submission Categories

Category	Word Limit	Eligibility
Long Articles	5,000 – 8,000 words	Open to all
Short Articles / Essays	3,000 – 5,000 words	Open to all
Notes & Comments	2,000 – 4,000 words	Open to all
Case Comments / Legislative Comments	1,500 – 3,000 words	Open to all

Interdisciplinary and comparative legal studies are strongly encouraged.

Submission Guidelines

1. Format- MS Word (.doc/.docx) only.

2. Font & Spacing- Times New Roman, Justified Alignment, 12 pt for text; 10 pt for footnotes. 1.5 line spacing for text; single spacing for footnotes.

3. Citation Style- ILI (Indian Law Institute) Citation Style (latest edition). Footnotes must conform strictly to ILI rules. Speaking footnotes are not permitted.

4. Abstract- Include an abstract of 150-250 words with 4-6 keywords.

5. Plagiarism- Submissions must be original and unpublished. Plagiarism above 10% or AI-generated content above 10% will lead to immediate rejection. Authors may be required to submit a declaration confirming the originality of their work.

6. Co-authorship- Permitted up to two authors.

7. Contact Information- Provide a separate cover page with:

- Title of paper
- Author name(s), designation, affiliation, ORCID (if any)
- Email
- Mobile number

Review Process

All submissions undergo a double-blind peer review process, wherein the identities of both the authors and the reviewers remain confidential to ensure objectivity and fairness. Manuscripts are evaluated on criteria including originality, relevance, methodological rigor, clarity of argument, and contribution to legal scholarship.

The Editorial Board conducts an initial screening to assess compliance with the submission guidelines and overall suitability. Submissions that do not meet the prescribed standards may be rejected at this stage.

Authors may be required to incorporate suggested revisions within a stipulated timeframe.

The decision of the Editorial Board shall be final.

Copyright & Publication Policy

Upon acceptance and publication, copyright shall vest with the Journal. Authors will not retain copyright over their submissions. However, authors shall continue to hold moral rights over

their work, including the right to be identified as the author and to protect the integrity of the work.

Submissions must be original and must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere at the time of submission. Simultaneous submissions to other journals, conferences, or platforms are strictly prohibited.
